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## <u>Weekly Wrap Up</u>

Contrary to what the distributors believed, we found that the prices of hydrated ethanol changed the rumor from March 8th, and closed the week on March 15th with prices recovering the same levels selected between the end of February and the beginning of the month current.

The strong outflows that will continue to occur have been supporting prices, even with many mills already crushing and others entering throughout March, in addition to the stock from the previous harvest. As a guideline and corroborating the previous information, you can use the data released by UNICA on March 12th, which closes production and sales for February and

adds up the rest of the harvest so far. In February, 2.82 billion liters of total ethanol, between anhydrous and hydrated, were sold, 998.800 million liters of anhydrous and 1.82 billion liters of hydrated.

Of these, 975.910 million liters of anhydrous and 1.68 billion liters of hydrated went to the domestic market, representing respectively an increase of 10.70% and 53.91% in relation to the same month of 2023.

In the accumulated harvest we have 18.08 billion liters of hydrated ethanol (+18.63%) and 11.68 billion liters of anhydrous (+1.35%), considering total sales for export and the domestic market.

For the domestic market alone, the total was 16.8 billion liters of hydrous and 10.73 billion liters of anhydrous.

And finally, the Plenary of the Chamber of Deputies in Brasilia approved on March 13th the Bill known as FUEL OF THE FUTURE, which establishes the legal framework for the biofuels sector. The Bill creates national programs for green diesel, sustainable aviation fuel and biomethane, in addition to increasing the mixture of ethanol and biodiesel in gasoline and diesel, respectively.

The proposal will be sent to the Senate

According to the proposal, a new margin for mixing ethanol with gasoline will go from 22% to 27%, and could reach 35%.

Currently, the mixture can reach 27.5%, with at least 18% ethanol. As for biodiesel, mixed with diesel of fossil origin at a percentage of 14% since March this year, from 2025 onwards, 1 percentage point will be added to the annual mixture until reaching 20% in March 2030, according to the second proposals in the text.
